For any systems located on a commercial radio site, the IACC requires signed authorization from the proposed site owner or manager. (This will not be made public)

All new systems have 6 months from approval to operational. The Applicant is required to keep the IACC apprised of construction states and the turn on date. No communication with the IACC, the application consideration will be dropped.

All new systems will be coordinated for five (5) years. The Coordination holder will be responsible to update any changes at any time and re coordinate the system at the end of the five (5) year term.
